Courts: Groups of 4 players rotate onto the courts as one group exits. Courts are not designated by skill level. Players from each skill level take turns rotating onto an open court.

Level play and Paddle Saddle use: Paddle saddles attached to the courts are used to manage the queue of players for three levels of play: Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced. Players are expected to place their paddle in the saddle for their appropriate skill level. As you develop your skill, you may want to advance to the next level (beginner to intermediate; intermediate to advanced). To play at the next level, place your paddle in the saddle. If you consistently lose games by a large margin, you should, or you may be asked to drop back to the lower level until you develop skills that will enable you to play at the higher level.

Ladders: Groups of 4 designated by skill level play 3 games to 15. Players scores are averaged and throughout the season players may move up (or down) based on wins/loses. You may attend any or all sessions, sign up for ladders must be 24 hours prior to scheduled play time. Visit rochesterpickleball.com (more tab) and use SignUpGenius to register.
